- There are several federal laws to be considered.
- Any equipment being purchased that will be attached to any structure or disturbs the ground in any way will require DHS/FEMA approval.
- You cannot segment costs to deter the NEPA review. An example would be if you purchase an antenna but the local jurisdiction pays for the installation, it would still require approval.
- When seeking approval, please make sure the scope of work is precise, detailed and clear. Please include all aspects and dimensions of the project. It will make the process quicker.
