

RECORD OF CHANGES

Changes made to the Ohio Emergency Management Plan are incorporated directly into the Plan as they are approved. A record of changes made to the Plan during the 2009 calendar year are listed in the table, below.

<p>Base Plan – Tab A, Primary and Support Agencies by ESF and Annex chart, was reviewed for accuracy and was expanded to include the Tabs and Attachments that include a list of Primary and Support Agencies. The Base Plan was reviewed and minor changes were made throughout to ensure that the plan is responsive to the current administrative and legislative environment.</p>
<p>ESF-1 - Transportation, Tab A - Aviation Plan – Minor changes were made to this ESF, including clarification of the responsibilities of the Ohio Wing of the Civil Air Patrol. This Tab was last updated in 2001.</p>
<p>ESF-1 - Transportation, Tab B - SNS/State Cache Transportation Plan – Minor changes were made to this ESF in response to the 2009 SNS activations.</p>
<p>ESF-3 - Engineering and Public Works – A review by the Primary Agency (Ohio Department of Natural Resources) and support agencies of this ESF did not result in any significant changes. This ESF was last updated in 2004.</p>
<p>ESF-3 - Engineering and Public Works, Tab A - Debris Management Plan – This newly-created plan was developed to define the roles and responsibilities of partner agencies to the Plan and to provide guidance for the development and implementation of all elements involved in managing debris removal operations. The Plan includes a Tab, the Agency Responsibilities by Debris Management Activity matrix, that provides an overview of the responsibilities of the Plan’s partner agencies.</p>
<p>ESF-4 – Firefighting – This ESF was reviewed by the Primary Agency (Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal) and by the ESF’s Support Agencies. The Ohio Fire Chief’s Association was added to the list of support agencies. This ESF was last updated in 2001.</p>
<p>ESF-8 - Public Health and Medical Services – Minor changes were made to the ESF following a review by the Primary Agency (Ohio Department of Health) and the support agencies. The ESF was last updated in 2005.</p>

ESF-11 - Food and Agriculture – The ESF was thoroughly reviewed by the Primary Agency and by the support agencies. The name of ESF-11 was changed from Agriculture to Food and Agriculture. A number of food-related elements were added to the ESF. This ESF was last updated in 2001.

ESF-13 - Law Enforcement – Minor changes were made to the ESF following a review by the Primary Agency (Ohio State Highway Patrol) and the support agencies. This ESF was last updated in 2001.

Drought Incident Annex – The Annex was reviewed by the Primary Agency (Ohio Emergency Management Agency) and by the support agencies. The changes that were made to the Annex in this year’s update included: 1) A discussion of the Standard Precipitation Index drought indicator was added to the Annex; 2) Attachment 4 - Disaster Assistance Programs, Attachment 5-Suggested Response Water- Use Class, and Attachment 7 - Ohio Suggested Drought Response Actions were removed from the Annex and were relocated to the Ohio EMA website under “Local Guidance”; 3) Attachment 6 - Drought Response Matrix was reformatted and was renumbered as Attachment 4; and 4) Other minor changes were made throughout the document in response to agency review feedback. This Annex was last updated in 2003.

Terrorism Incident Annex – The Annex was reviewed by the Primary Agency (Ohio Emergency Management Agency) and by the support agencies. A major rewrite of Annex was completed that addresses and incorporates elements of FEMA’s Target Capability Lists. Minor updates were last made to this Annex in 2008.
