The Ohio Department of Public Safety, Ohio Emergency Management Agency is pleased to announce the competitive awards selected as part of the 2015 State Homeland Security competitive process. With applications in excess of \$17 million for an approximate \$3.4 million in funding, it is critical that the best projects are funded. Applications went through a peer review of subject matter experts to include representatives from County Emergency Management Agencies, Ohio Department of Commerce/State Fire Marshal, Ohio Department of Health, Ohio Emergency Management Agency, and Ohio Homeland Security.
