

## ODH Crosswalk for Ebola Exposure and Risk Intervention

<p><b>Any direct contact</b> Any direct skin to skin or mucus membrane contact or contact with blood and body fluids without personal protective equipment</p>	<p>3 page questionnaire or the more detailed standardized tool to evaluate risk</p>	<p>Quarantine.  No commercial conveyance for 21 days after last contact</p>
<p><b>No direct contact, within risk zone</b> No direct skin to skin or mucus membrane contact or contact with blood and body fluids.  within a 3 foot radius ("risk zone") of an infected individual greater than 1 hour</p>		<p><b>Active monitoring</b> (twice daily temperature taking once directly observed by public health official for 21 days after last contact)  No commercial conveyance for 21 days after the last contact  Any travel outside of the jurisdiction of the local health authority must be under mutual agreement of the health authority of jurisdiction and the public health official who will assume responsibility for daily observation.</p>
<p><b>No direct contact, not in risk zone</b> No direct contact (not in the "risk zone"), but in the same enclosed space of infected individual</p>	<p>≥ 1 hour</p>	<p><b>Verified self-monitoring</b> (twice daily temperature taking reported daily to public health official) for 21 days after last contact  No travel outside of the country due to the inability to verify and act upon non-compliance with reporting requirements.</p>
<p><b>No direct contact, not in risk zone</b> No direct contact (not in the "risk zone"), but in the same enclosed space of infected individual</p>	<p>&lt; 1 hour</p>	<p><b>Self-monitoring</b> (twice daily temperature taking, no reporting to public health) for 21 days after last contact</p>
<p><b>No direct contact, in broad vicinity</b> No direct contact, but within broad vicinity</p>		<p>Provide education</p>

All individuals shall be given written notice of their exposure category and the intervention and sign acknowledgement of the notice. The notice shall also apprise the individual of their responsibility to notify any first responder they come in contact with of their exposure category and intervention.
