

**Ohio EMA Spot Report– August 4, 2014**  
**Toledo Water Issue (Lucas County)**

**Incident Status Change**

Due to the determination by the City of Toledo's water system that the drinking water is confirmed to be safe to drink, the State of Ohio's Emergency Operations Center is now planning the demobilization and recovery of assets and personnel.

NOTE: This is not a termination of this incident. State agencies currently engaged in missions should contact their leadership for guidance on actions for the remainder of the incident.

Current priorities are now:

1. Planning on the recovery of and long-term storage of purchased and produced water. This resource will be stored so that it is immediately available should a need arise again.
2. Planning on the determination of disposition of produced bulk water.
3. Execution of pick up, movement, off-loading and storage of bottled water
4. Continue working with and communicating information to state, county, federal and non-governmental response partners
