

MGT-385 Community Cyber Security Exercise Planning MGT-385
Delivered by Ohio EMA/ Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX)
November 14-16, 2012

Course Description:

This 2.5-day course is designed to assist exercise planners in incorporating cyber into an exercise in meaningful ways. Participants will be introduced to cyber topics and how cyber can impact the business operations of an organization and community. Presentations and activities will explore objectives, players, cyber injects and challenges associated with incorporating cyber into exercises. Participants will be exposed to many possible injects and scenarios that can be used in cyber-based exercises.



The course will consist of an awareness session on day 1 and then focus on cyber exercise planning specifics for the remainder of the course. The course is intended for exercise planners and does **NOT** require a background in Information Technology.
