- II. **Summary:** Janelle provided an overview of the upcoming SAR Conference. I have attached the flyer as well. Ken and Deana have not been able to complete the grant application, but have compiled an inventory of necessary trainings.

Sandy, Deana and Janelle will provide this information to all others that may need it.
