# INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE UNDER DR-4447

## First Individual Assistance declaration for Ohio since 2007

- **Disaster Survivor Assistance Teams**

- These FEMA employees will go door to door, to community events, etc. to engage with disaster survivors to ensure they have registered for assistance, etc.
- They will be in your counties within days of the declaration. They should coordinate with the County EMA office ahead of deployment into the communities

- **Disaster Case Management**

- Grant from FEMA; difficult application process and not always approved
- Communities should consider pre-disaster development of case management process for local long term recovery efforts

- **Disaster Recovery Centers**

- Locations established in partnership with the County EMA office



# STATE DISASTER RELIEF PROGRAM UPDATE

- **Currently there are 11 open disasters under the State Disaster Relief Program**
- **Open disaster dates range from February 2017 through July 2019**
- **Declared Counties:**
  - **Athens, Belmont, Brown, Carroll, Clermont, Fairfield, Hocking, Jefferson, Logan, Meigs, Mercer, Ottawa, Perry, Pike, Trumbull**
- **Total Number of Applicants**
  - **131**
- **Total Approximate Cost**
  - **\$16,198,900**




# MONTGOMERY COUNTY DEBRIS MISSION

- **The State Emergency Operations Center received a mission request from Montgomery County EMA requesting assistance with the removal of debris from two temporary debris storage areas.**
- **Mission was completed within 8 days utilizing various recourses including:**
  - **Various sizes of trucks procured through contracts**
    - A total of 983 truckloads were taken to final disposal sites
  - **ODOT Loaders/Operators**
    - Loaders/Operators were able to provide average loading times between 6-7 minutes
  - **Ohio Military Reserve**
    - Provided debris monitoring operations
  - **Survey123 Application**
    - Allowed for real-time data and analytics to be shared with stakeholders






# DR-4424 SOUTHEAST SPRING FLOODS DECLARED APRIL 8, 2019

- Total HMGP estimate \$8,033,015
- Pre-applications due July 10, 2019
- 73 pre-applications requesting \$64.4 Million
- 18 full applications being developed for \$13.2 Million
  - 14 acquisition/demolition projects for approx. 57 structures
  - 2 elevation projects for 16 structures
  - 2 community safe rooms

# DR-4447 MEMORIAL DAY TORNADOES DECLARED JUNE 18, 2019

- Total HMGP estimate \$5,274,404
- Pre-applications due August 30, 2019
- 65 pre-applications requesting \$64.4 Million
- 20 full applications being developed for \$15.1 Million
  - 10 acquisition/demolition projects for approx. 79 structures and 1 hospital
  - 5 storm water projects
  - 3 advanced assistance
  - 2 siren projects
