

County EMA and County Public Health,

Overview

Counties do NOT need to enter a mission into WebEOC before securing non-congregate quarantine housing. Any local government can assess the need for non-congregate sheltering and proceed as necessary. However, please email me to let me know you are setting up non-congregate quarantine housing so that we can keep awareness and support if necessary. **Please send me the following if you do set up a site: facility name, facility address, number of rooms/persons, check-in date and expected check-out date.**

Attached is the most current list of potential hotels, ODNR cabins and higher education facilities. You can also find a map of these locations that is updated daily here: <https://arcg.is/1K9P9i>

The hope is that the County EMA and County Public Health are working in tandem with one another to avoid duplication of effort and maintain a coordinated response.

Process:

Hotels

County Public Health/County EMA will reach out to the hotel directly to seek room(s). The room cost does not necessarily need to be the GSA rate, but should be reasonable.

ODNR Cabins

County Public Health/County EMA will reach out to ODNR (Doug Johnson doug.johnson@dnr.state.oh.us 614-265-7073 or Eric Reed Eric.Reed@dnr.state.oh.us 614-204-4950). ODNR is developing an MOU that will be utilized with the requestor for their facilities. When you contact ODNR they will provide the MOU and information on the facilities

Higher Education

County Public Health/County EMA should reach out to the contact for the facility in the attached spreadsheet. Also, attached is a MOU that can be used between the counties and the Higher Education facility. For clarification on the attached MOU please email Ann Vitale apvitale@dps.ohio.gov

Funding

The county agency lead for securing the non-congregate housing will be responsible for funding the housing. However, the costs associated with non-congregate sheltering may be a reimbursable cost under the FEMA Public Assistance Program.
